- *Copyediting – The prices of copyediting services vary depending on the length of your manuscript.*

- *Indexing – The prices of the Heart.Ink Press indexing services vary depending on the length of your manuscript.*

- *Supply your own Index for a minimal fee of \$49.99.*
 - Prepare your book file in a recent version of a Microsoft Word or WordPerfect compatible software and its indexing feature.
 - After corrections, Heart.InkPress can provide a paper galley of your book that you can use as a reference for creating your index. Create the index as a separate text file and submit it on a disk to Heart.InkPress. The index will be placed at the end of the book and you will be sent a confirmation galley.
- *Alterations and corrections – to correct any typos and errors you might have missed.*
 - For black and white publishing – base fee of \$20 for each round of corrections to interior/text, plus 2\$ per alteration
 - - base fee of \$20 for each round of corrections to book cover
 - - includes additional galley or cover proof as applicable
 - - instructions provided with galley proof delivery
 - -alteration of production files and final printing files to reflect changes
 Post-publication services are available for a flat fee of \$150.
 - For full color publishing – base fee of \$45 for each round of corrections to interior layout, text, or cover
 - - \$2 per alteration
 - - includes additional galley or cover proof as applicable
 - - instructions provided with galley proof delivery
 - - ability to make text edits, color and font changes, and image/design alterations
 - -alteration of production files and final printing files to reflect change
 Post-publication services are available for a flat fee of \$250.

*Post-publication services include corrections requested after publication such as updated content or detail changes.

Note: Heart.Ink Press authors retain the rights to their work, have control over their book design, have their book placed on distributors list, target their niche audience, earn royalties, can print copies of their book on demand, have access to a team of individuals dedicated to customer service satisfaction.
